AWARDS

Contributor of the Year

(open to the public to nominate)

This is recognition that may be awarded annually to an individual, group or sponsor who demonstrates outstanding support for the sport of biathlon and/or makes a significant contribution to the growth, development or leadership of BPEI.

Volunteer of the Year

In Memory of Jack MacKinnon

(open to the public to nominate)

This is recognition that will be awarded annually to an individual volunteer to recognize contributions and accomplishments during the past year, as well as contributions and achievements over a number of years.

Most Improved Learn to Ski

(open to coaches only to nominate)

This award may be granted annually to an athlete in the Learn to Ski program who in the estimate of the coaches makes the greatest progress in cross country skiing.

Most Improved Bear

(open to coaches only to nominate)

This is a recognition award that may be awarded annually to the BPEI Bear who over the season had the greatest improvement in skiing and shooting skills. The award will also take in account attendance at practice and attitude. Only one gender neutral award will be presented.

Biathlete Rookie of the Year

(open to coaches only to nominate)

This is recognition that may be awarded annually to a 1st year BPEI athlete either in the competitive or recreation stream, who demonstrated enthusiasm for the sport, consistent attendance and participation in practice and competes in at least one BPEI sanctioned event. Only one gender neutral award will be presented.

Top Shot Bear

(coaches only must provide stats)

This is a recognition award that may be awarded annually to the BPEI Bear athlete who achieves the highest shooting percentage in competition for the season. The award winner must compete in at least 2 events of the season. Only one gender neutral award will be presented

Most Improved Biathlete

(coaches only must provide stats)

This is a recognition award that may be awarded annually to the most improved BPEI athlete over the past season, as evidenced by an increase in both ski speed and hits. The athlete must take part in at least 2 events (4 races) in order to be considered. Only one gender neutral award will be presented.

Top Shot Biathlete

(coaches only must provide stats)

This is a recognition award that may be awarded annually to the BPEI biathlon athlete who achieves the highest shooting percentage in competition for the entire season. The award winner must compete in at least 2 events of the season. Only one gender neutral award will be presented.

Athletes of the Year (Awards of Distinction)

(open to the public to nominate)

This is a recognition award that may be awarded annually to a BPEI athlete who demonstrates a strong commitment to training and whose personal achievements and excellence are reflected in regional / national/ international competition ranking. The award recognizes an athlete who demonstrates a strong commitment to, and who acts as a good ambassador for, the sport of Biathlon. The award is open to both male and female athletes; multiple awards can be given each year.
